ANSWERS

1. The first destination is the Shrine of the Book in the Israel Museum. In the video it is mentioned that you need to meet the contact person in the Israel Museum.
2. The solution for the Shrine of the Book's task is the **C**hurch of the **H**oly **S**epulcher (CHS). Another clue to the next destination is the Cross, which is the principal symbol of the Christian religion.
3. The solution of the **C**hurch of the **H**oly **S**epulcher's task is Temple Mount (a drawing of a temple + a drawing of a house).
4. The solution of the Temple Mount's task is The Western Wall Tunnels. The full text is:

DURING THE REIGN OF HEROD THE GREAT, AN ARTIFICIAL EXPANSION WAS BUILT ON THE ORIGINAL HILL OF MOUNT MORIAH – THAT CREATED A LARGE PLAZA ON WHICH THE REFURBISHED AND MAGNIFICENT TEMPLE WAS BUILT.

The hidden letters under the spots create the word “UNDERGROUND”, which implies for the Western Walls Tunnels, that are underground tunnels.

5. The solution of the Western Wall Tunnels' task is the Cathedral of Saint James. The right path goes through the vase is of the man on the left side. The code that you get is: 19730.
6. The solution of the Cathedral of Saint James's task is the Market. The images in this task represent the words of the song “Jerusalem of Gold”:

The mountain air is clear as **wine**

And the scent of **pin**es

Is carried on the **bre**eze of twilight

With the sound of **bell**s.

And in the slumber of tree and **ston**e

Captured in her **dream**

The city that **sits** solitary

And in its midst is a **wall**.

The next phrase is “Jerusalem of **Gold**”. When we exchange the word GOLD – we get the word MARKET.







11. The solution of the Dome of the Rock's task in Lion's gate. First you need to locate the names of the gates of the Old City Walls: Zion, Lions, New, Dung, Jaffa, Golden, Damascus and Herod. Second, you need to write the numbers, that are next to the names, starting for the Golden Gate (that is closed) clockwise according to the map. The code that you get is 18965730.
12. The solution of the Lions' gate's task is the Western Wall. This is a navigation task. When you exit through the Lions' gate and continue south – The first opened gate is the Dung Gate. When you enter this gate and continue straight – you arrive to the Western Wall plaza.
13. The Solution of the Western Wall's task is the code 968423 – According to the timeline: King David -> First Temple -> Herod the Great (Second Temple period) -> Jesus -> Muhammad -> Building the Walls of Jerusalem (Ottoman period)
